

Release of Holdback

Alberta Transportation retains holdback from each contract according to Section 1.2.26 (Payment and Holdback) of the General Specifications, Specification Amendments and Supplemental Specifications for Highway and Bridge Construction (Edition 15, 2013) as amended and updated from time to time – refer to this document for more information.

Holdback will be retained for a minimum of 45 days after the date of Construction Completion, and will not be release until all the work is completed on the contract, the final estimate has been processed for payment, and there are no third party claims filed with Alberta Transportation.

The Contractor is required to submit the following documents to Tender Administration prior to any release of holdback:

- The Construction Completion Certificate
- The final progress estimate
- An executed Statutory Declaration (the original document is required – the form can be found on the Alberta Transportation website)
- A Worker's Compensation Board letter of release
- Written confirmation of full environmental compliance
- Any written warranty requirements (project specific)
